

**ORDINANCE NO: 2015-05-18**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVERTON, TEXAS CANVASSING THE VOTES FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD MAY 9, 2015 AN TO REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO USE TYPE A FUNDS FROM THE OVERTON ECONOMIC DELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR TYPE B PROJECTS FOR PROPOSITIONS #1, #2, #3, #4 AND #5

**WHEREAS**, a special election on five (5) ballot propositions requesting authorization from the citizens of the City of Overton to use Type A funds from The Overton Economic Development Corporation for Type B projects was held on May 9, 2015 and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has met and canvassed the votes on such propositions; and

**WHEREAS**, the canvass shows the following results:

<b><u>Proposition #1</u></b>				
“Authorize the Overton Economic Development Corporation to use sales and use tax revenue, including any amount previously authorized and collected, for Water, Sewer and Street Capital Improvements such as replacement of Water/Sewer Lines and re-paving of alleyways in the downtown business district between Overton and South Street east of Commerce St (replace fire hydrants, manholes and install valves). Total costs of projects in Proposition # 1 not to exceed <u>\$280,000.00.</u> ”

<b><u>Proposition #2</u></b>				
“Authorize the Overton Economic Development Corporation to use sales and use tax revenue, including any amount previously authorized and collected, for Street Network Capital Improvements which include reconstruction and/or renovation of the following roads and roadway intersections: the end of Commerce Street intersection with Overton Street at the railroad crossing, re-paving of North Commerce Street from Overton Street to Elm Street, and re-construction of the intersection at Holland Street and Main Street, install suitable storm drain from Overton High School to Hwy 135 and replace sewer lines. Total costs of projects in Proposition # 2 not to exceed <u>\$250,000.00.</u> ”

**Proposition #3**

“Authorize the Overton Economic Development Corporation to use sales and use tax revenue, including any amount previously authorized and collected, for North Overton Lake dam improvements that will stabilize the slide area and reinforce the embankment on the west end of the dam to prevent further erosion and possible breaching. Total costs of projects in Proposition # 3 not to exceed \$229,000.00.”

“Authorize the Overton Economic Development Corporation to use sales and use tax revenue, including any amount previously authorized and collected, for Overton Lake, North Lake Dam Improvements, to design, demolish the existing service spillway and reconstruct a new one plus employ erosion control mechanisms from the service spillway to Hwy 850. Total costs of projects in Proposition # 4 not to exceed \$264,000.00.”

“Authorize the Overton Economic Development Corporation to use sales and use tax revenue, including any amount previously authorized and collected, for Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements to upgrade the Clarifier and Weirs, and upgrade Chlorine Contact Chamber at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Total costs of projects in Proposition # 5 not to exceed \$125,000.00.”

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVERTON, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1:** THAT the above canvass be and the same is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: THAT the Overton Economic Development Corporation is hereby authorized by the citizens of the City of Overton to spend Type A funds for the above Type B projects as described in Propositions #1, #2, #3, #4 and #5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and execution.


