Couch Survey A-205, legally described as all that certain tract, lot or parcel of land, a part of the J. Couch Survey A-205, Rusk County Texas and also being all of that certain called 1.00 acre tract of land described in a deed dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2010 that is recorded as Instrument Number 00094240, Volume 3006, Page 250-252 of the Official Public Records of Rusk County, Texas and being more commonly referred to as 1710 E FM 850, Overton, Rusk County, Texas by the Rusk Count Appraisal District records for Parcel ID 3054..

Commission to hear staff report and take action to make a recommendation to City Council regarding Variance Application 2019-06—Horacio Perez Vasquez request for a variance from the City of Overton Design Standards Regulations, Section 106.1 Sidewalk Requirements and Section 111.3 Parking: Standard Curb and Gutter Requirements. Specifically, applicant is requesting a variance to not install a sidewalk along FM 850 adjacent to the subject property. The subject property is a 0.96-acre tract of land out of the J.
