



**PROCLAMATION
2020 OVERTON
“CITY WIDE SPRING CLEAN UP DAYS”**

WHEREAS, the City of Overton, in conjunction with Rusk County and the State of Texas efforts through the “Don’t Mess with Texas”/ Rusk County Trash Off Event”, is organizing a Community Spring Clean Up Day to ensure that the natural beauty of our community and a clean environment are a source of great pride for the citizens of Overton; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Overton have determined it is important to promote environmental cleanliness within the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Overton recognizes the citizens’ desire to have a “clean” City which everyone can be proud to live in; and

WHEREAS, the City of Overton recognizes that the enforcement of our Public Nuisance Ordinances shall markedly improve the aesthetic appearance of our community’s lands, waterways, safety, health and welfare of all our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Overton recognizes that while significant strides have been made to abate litter, there remains a large amount of debris and rubbish on public and private lands; and

WHEREAS, the City of Overton feels that it is in the public interest to set aside a designated date and time so that homeowners and property owners may clean their property of trash, old furniture and or appliances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Overton, directs staff to provide logistical support in the form of dumpsters and the Public Works staff to assist residents of Overton with the disposal of large bulky household items such as sofas, mattresses, furniture, appliances, fencing and clothes.


