**RATIFICATION OF THE AMENDED ORDER OF  
THE DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH  
EMERGENCY ISSUED FOR SMITH COUNTY ON MARCH 27, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, in response to the Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency issued by Smith County Judge Nathaniel Moran and ratified by Smith County Commissioners Court on March 17, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020, I, C. R. Evans, as Mayor of the City of Overton, Texas, issued a Local Disaster of Public Health Emergency Declaration for the City of Overton resulting from the global pandemic of the novel coronavirus designated SARS-CoV2 which causes the disease COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 19, 2020, the City Council of the City of Overton took action to approve Resolution No. 2019.03.19A extending Local Disaster of Public Health Emergency Declaration for the City of Overton through April 16, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2020, Smith County Judge Nathaniel Moran signed the **Amended Order of Declaration of Local Disaster due to Public Health Emergency adding a clause for a Stay at Home Order**; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating the aforesaid Declarations continue to exist; and

**WHEREAS**, the city limits of Overton extend into both Smith and Rusk Counties; and


**WHEREAS, in order to provide consistent guidance and services to the entire Overton community it is necessary to ratify the Smith County order to be in effect for both the Smith and Rusk county portions of Overton.**

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF OVERTON, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the document titled, "Amended Order of Declaration of Local Disaster due to Public Health Emergency" proclaimed and ordered by Smith County Judge Nathaniel Moran on March 27, 2020 is hereby ratified for the entire incorporated limits of the City of Overton.

**SECTION 2.** That all provisions of this Order shall become effective at 12:01 am on April 2, 2020 and shall continue in effect until 11:59 pm on April 10, 2020; however, if the Smith County order is extended, this order will automatically be extended to cover any extensions issued by Smith County.
