All regulated trucks are prohibited from all city streets and alleys except upon the designated truck routes set forth below and except that such vehicles may be operated on other streets and alleys only for the purpose of pickup and delivery of materials and then only by entering such street at the intersection nearest the designation of the vehicle and proceeding thereon no further than the next intersection thereafter.

SECTION 2. Added Section

That the following Section of Chapter 60: Traffic Regulations is hereby added to read as follows:

§ 60.23 TRUCK ROUTE

Sections:

60.23.030 Penalty for violations

§ 60.30 Penalty for Violations

Any person who violates any provision of the Ordinance may be punishable by a fine of up to the maximum amount as allowed by law. Each day during which a violation continues shall be a separate offense.

SECTION 3. Severability

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation of this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4. Conflict

Any provisions of any prior ordinance of the City whether codified or uncodified, which are in conflict with any provision of the Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict, but all other provisions of the ordinances of the City whether codified or uncodified, which are not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.
