The subject property is a tract of land legally described as Lot 2R1 and 2R2, Block 1 of the Hillcrest Addition a replat of Lot 2R, Block 1, Hillcrest Addition as shown according to plat thereof recorded in Sleeve 488 of the Plat Records of Rusk County, Texas. The subject property is more commonly referred to as 501 East Crews Street, Overton, Rusk County, Texas.

Councilmember Thompson made a motion to approve and Councilmember Williams seconded the motion.


Motion carried 4-0 with Councilmember Hall recusing
