Discuss and approve sales of excess city property- Sewer Truck with locked up motor, three Pick-Up's barely running, and one old backhoe. Councilman Williams made the motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Hall. Passed 4/0

Bill Webster of Linebarger and Sloan spoke on a struck off re-sale property that has a current bid. Requesting Mayor Gilbert have council permission to sign off on the sale. Councilman Hall made motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Williams, passed 4/0

Discuss and take action on OEDC re-imbursement of OMDD \$12960 for purchase of fire hydrants billed to OMDD in error and OMDD allocating \$1200 for supplies to paint the OVFD.

Blake Armstrong the City's Legal Council spoke on the question of the OMDD by-Laws stating the City Council must approve all projects with no financial limits.
